

## Task Card 5: Re-telling what you have learnt about the city of Plauen

Using your work from the last 4 lessons, create a PowerPoint or presentation called 'Jewish life in Plauen before the war'. Aim to include:

- The small number of Jewish people (less than 0.75%) in Germany before the Second World War.
- The geographical location of Plauen.
- The development of Plauen as a lace city and the way it declined.
- How the city's growth and fall helped contribute to the antisemitic behaviour.
- The history of the city in the context of wider events.
- The history of the Jewish and non-Jewish people who lived there.
